






A DESIRE TO MAKE A DIFFERENCE

"Build it and they will come." Everyone is familiar with this line from the movie Field of Dreams. But how many of us would take it literally? Brian Bordainick did just that. In the neighborhood of Desire sits George Washington Carver High-a school devastated by Katrina. It was here that Athletic Director, Brian Bordainick had his own dream to create a state-of-the-art athletic facility. A true grassroots effort, the drive eventually caught the attention of the NFL and Nike. To date, the Field of Dreams project has raised \$1,499,500 of its \$1.85 million goal. GNOF is proud to house and administer the Field of Dreams Fund.

She and her husband, Harry, created the Harry Wade Jones and Dr. Stella Pinkney Jones Family Fund. Their fund is dedicated to supporting the arts and other causes close to their hearts. One reason the Joneses started their fund was to set an example of giving to their four children.



OPPORTUNITY



Partnering with the Mayor's office and the National Fund for Workforce Solutions, GNOF will receive a grant totaling \$600,000 with matching funds. GNOF will use this grant to support workforce training programs designed to prepare local workers for the thousands of jobs that will soon be generated in the biotech and healthcare sectors.


INVESTMENT PERFORMANCE
